We have united as an artistic community to ask for your support at this time. ARTIST BIO

Andy Bellomo is a visual artist, public mural artist, teacher and performer living and working in Chicago. She received her Master's in Education in Creative Arts in Learning from Lesley University in 2005. She has been creating large-scale public murals for over 10 years. Additionally, she specializes in stained glass artworks creating large glass pieces for galleries and homes across the U.S. Her work can be seen in Chicago and across the country. As a full-time artist, she divides her time between creating murals, educating youth, doing commissioned glass work and performing as a drag king. Andy has a strong belief in collaboration and cross-promoting fellow artists and community members. She is a dynamic member of the arts and LGBTQ communities and a strong activist and advocate for social change and human rights. Andy is also the creator and co-producer of Queer Lines, an annual three-part visual art, poetry, and drag king show.

Andy's most recent collaborative mural, "The Love I Vibrate," is depicted on the cover of the book, Art in Chicago Neighborhoods: Year of Public Art, a public art catalogue created by the Chicago Department of Cultural Affairs & Special Events (DCASE)/City of Chicago. In addition, she was awarded public art grants by The Field Museum, DCASE, and the Chicago Park District.

Her current studio work includes the Queer Mural Series with the above mural, "The Love I Vibrate," being the first in this collection. This is a series of murals that highlights the hard work and activism of the LGBTQ community in Chicago. Each mural features an Artist Activist who has been using art to create social change, demand social justice, while supporting and bringing our community together. ARTIST BIO

Born in 1987 in the border town of Acuña, Mexico, Fernando Andrade has lived in San Antonio, Texas, since he was seven years old. During Andrade's early childhood years, it was considered safe for children to play outside and he remembers playing outdoor games with his family during those years. Today, however, the neighborhood where Andrade was raised is troubled with ongoing violence brought on by the leaders of drug cartels. Informed of the dire situation through stories told by friends and relatives, as well as by news reports, books, and online media, Andrade is disheartened that his hometown and other areas south of the U.S./Mexico border have become places of violence where people are disappearing or dying on a daily basis. Drug leaders intimidate and murder innocent victims, often disposing of bodies in barrels of acid or by filling garbage bags with body parts. For Andrade, the situation became personal in 2012, when a friend of his went missing, never to be seen again.

As an artist, Andrade copes with the turmoil in his native homeland with two distinct bodies of work: figurative drawings and abstract paintings. While the drawings are narrative explorations of the events taking place, the paintings are vehicles for nurturing feelings of hopeful joy and optimism.

In his figurative drawings, Andrade creates simple narratives based on stories he has heard about border violence. Believing that everyone has their own childhood memories and can identify with the innocence of youth, Andrade stages his scenarios using children in place of adults, a strategy for enticing viewers to engage in his conversation. He omits background details allowing viewers to project their own visualizations into each scene, and depicts wooden sticks, which he remembers playing with as a child, as metaphors for guns. In his series A Jugar la Guerrita (To Play a Little War), a young boy appears with a stick that is spewing off-color phrases in Spanish, in reference to the corruption that now pervades the region. In the series Tierra y Libertad (Land and Liberty), groups of children appear to be playing childhood games but, upon closer inspection, are surrogates for the perpetrators and their victims. In his God Bless America series, Andrade calls attention to the dangers of guns by superimposing intricately detailed images of branches over barely visible phrases relating to the American gun culture.


In his abstract paintings, Andrade expresses a freedom from the anguish that underlies his figurative works. Working improvisationally, the artist creates organic compositions that are colorful and animated. Viewing his process as a kind of spiritual meditation, Andrade becomes free to imagine cosmic visions that have rhythmic affinities with music or dance, and which celebrate the splendor and preciousness of life itself.





ARTIST BIO

Launching a visual arts career in Chicago at the age of 15, Sandra Antongiorgi had the rare opportunity to study under renowned muralists and artists, including Keith Haring. Known primarily for her gifted use of paint, and formation of concept, Antongiorgi has contributed to scores of murals that dot the Chicago cityscape. Her work has been showcased in several museums and exhibitions, including The National Museum of Mexican Art, Zhou B Gallery and most recently a solo exhibit at Advocate & Gochis Galleries in Los Angeles and the Center on Halsted Gallery. Antongiorgi has led and collaborated on many murals including, Weaving Cultures, which won the Chicago Readers, "Best Mural of 2017". The mural is unique in that it features a transgender Latina, serves to bridge the gap between divided neighborhoods and honors underrepresented women of color. One of Antongiorgi's more recent mural collaborations, "The Love I Vibrate" is an inaugural mural honoring our non-binary community members. In 2018 her collaborative mural, "Es Tiempo de Recordar" a longstanding iconic mural in Chicago was whitewashed by the city. This erasure immediately launched Antongiorgi into advocacy for the anti-erasure of murals, and pushing for a permanent public mural registry that would preserve and protect cultural murals in the City of Chicago. Subsequently, a registry is being established to catalogue and commemorate outdoor murals across the City of Chicago, and prevent complete removal or destruction. As a studio artist, Antongiorgi draws upon life experiences, power relationships, culture, boundaries, mysticism and spirituality. She explores the way in which social stigmatization is internalized, inhibiting the ability to see ones abundant beauty and uses the human biology to reveal the inherent splendor within each and every one of us. Antongiorgi is dedicated to recognizing and responding to suffering. Her works expose the damage caused by family violence, incarceration and systematic marginalization. Antongiorgi's work delves deeply into those struggles normally hidden from view. She invites us to see where many turn a blind eye.

Salvador Vega has been an artist and muralist in Chicago since the 1970s. He attended Harrison High School and went on to the Art Institute of Chicago. As a student he was part of the protests demanding better education that resulted in the building of Benito Juarez HS. He was also a key leader demanding more rights and representation at the Art Institute and led the walkouts as a student there.

For four decades he has been part of the most significant large-scale murals and commercial signage in Chicago, from community murals in schools and banks to factories and warehouses, Vega has been at the upper tier of maestros of the genres.

He is often the technical support for artists pushing their own boundaries concerning scale and style.

His color choice and geometric flows in composition elevated art to a new era in design and stamped Chicago art with a distinctive recognizable voice. Together with his social-political ideology and roots in social action, Salvador is one of the few artists who manages to never compromise substance over style.

ARTIST BIO

Born May 11, 1995 in Vienna, Virginia. His parents who immigrated from Guatemala and Bolivia exposed Santana to painting in a non-creative way while working in his father's construction company in his early teen years. During the recession of 2008, him and his father would remove objects and furniture from foreclosed homes, then clean and paint the walls white, leaving no trace of its inhabitants. This was an emotional process for Santana but also gave him an awakening of value for material and life. Painting almost five houses a day, Santana began to realize the skid marks and stains, capturing movements of families who would live in the home prior to cleaning. Working with his father he learned the importance of aesthetics and functionality, he decided to pursue a more artistic practice and came to study at Columbia College Chicago in 2014. Upon moving to Chicago he was surrounded by creatives from all different realms: musicians, filmmakers, photographers, street artists, all great influences. The community Santana found himself in allowed for him to gain knowledge of different methods of painting, and support in the local industry. Through Santana's paintings, drawings, and mixed media artworks, we are taken on deconstructed journeys. American landscapes, personal life events and celestial imagery are composed through Santana's 'Micro-Collision' of marks and mediums. The vast openness of the canvas gives the viewer a chance to see the paintings as a much bigger part of the surrounding space, colors are transforming, transmuting, unlocking the passage of reality to a dream world. The minimal contents of his work makes us question if what Santana makes are paintings at all, it is puzzling and weird. There is an intriguing dark side but also formal precision. Roland Santana is a rainbow ranging from electric lime green to melancholic shades of purple and pink. He is luminous and dark. Today Roland Santana has gained the likes of several galleries and collectors and has participated in showcases in spaces such as Mana Contemporary, Chicago Art Department, Workshop 4200, Heaven Gallery, Chuquimarca Projects and more.



ARTIST BIO

Kory was born and raised in Cedar Rapids, Iowa to a father involved in local politics turned pastor and a late mother who was an architectural engineer. His first camera was a Fisher Price Polaroid camera he got as a child for Christmas. The camera fascinated him but with 3 other siblings in the household it was financially impossible to acquire photography equipment during his young developmental years to feed his disposition.

The artist in Kory was still apparent in his younger years and he turned to acting and stand-up comedy for creative release. Performing in Iowa, without a solid direction, he was torn between pharmacy school and following his talents as an artist. On the first day of pharmacy school Kory's mother died of cancer and in those moments Kory realized how short and precious life truly is and he decided to give up pharmacy school and moved to Los Angeles to pursue an acting career.

Living in L.A. he found himself going through the typical starving artist lifestyle of living in his car for months at a time but trained as an actor with James Dean's and Marlon Brando's acting coach Zina Provendie all the while. At the same time he was studying sketch/improv at the L.A. Connection Improv Theater as well. The week of graduation from improv school he got a call from MTV per the request of his childhood friend Ashton Kutcher. Kory was to report to a random garage for a project to shoot a commercial. His performance in the commercial went well and he was cast for several episodes of MTV's Punk'd. This work laid the ground work for him as an actor and he moved to New York shortly after and booked a role on Law and Order: Criminal Intent along with a handful of other films and radio commercials.

In 2008 following the not-so-successful American release of international film "Loins of Punjab" Kory returned to his hometown and started his own web content production company focused on photography and video. Since then Kory has been developing his skills behind the camera and investing in professional equipment.

As a photographer one of his highlights was a 2015 trek to the Eastern Himalayas via Malaysia, Thailand and Burma that produced some of his greatest images of remote regions to date. ARTIST BIO

Born in Manila, Philippines, Eulalio Fabie Silva, III was named after his father who is an internationally acclaimed artist. De Silva grew up within an artistic environment which led him to follow in his father's footsteps by pursuing the visual arts. Eulalio emigrated to the United States in 1980 and later continued his quest to become an artist while attending the School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 1989.

De Silva draws inspiration from the famed Gauguin's ever questioning stance: D'où Venons Nous / Que Sommes Nous / Où Allons Nous (Where Do We Come From? What Are We? Where Are We Going?)... the question of our own identity, our immediate surroundings, and other beings. De Silva's main influences are from the plein-air artists and abstract expressionists of the 50's and 60's that favor the formal qualities of a painting process of building then rebuilding, creating then defacing while giving importance on expressing the internal turmoil and triumphs through brushstrokes and color.

Waiting To Meditate is a series inspired by recent meditations of ourselves as light beings with the physical bodies, the works in this series are expressions as well as explorations of that energy, light, and dilemma.


Subtle humor rests within the title in itself as a double-entendre in which seeing ourselves as hesitant beings not yet becoming towards our realization that we are already light creatures – meaning that we were already "created in the image of God or creator." Therefore, "waiting" is an enigmatic and self-created symbolism by us. This self-fabrication is what separates us from those already self-realized such as the sages, the holies and/or the simple beings who professed simplicity in life in knowing that we are one with our surroundings.

With the undertones of Buddhist/Taoists within these pieces, the surroundings show the splendor of nature or the banalities of the urban space or tenements – in one's bedroom or living room space. These pieces are meant to parody ourselves in the midst of our busy lives whether we are in the 'rat race' to upend someone in the professional and corporate ladder or simply busy with our family lives. Like a detached actor in a play – on his/her soliloquy. Waiting for what? Waiting for whom? Or is he/she really waiting?
